



**Joint Medal Class Specifications  
Los Angeles Hunter Jumper Association  
and  
Southern California Horse Show Association**



LAHJA and SCHSA are offering the following joint medal classes so more riders can qualify for medal finals without having to show in more classes at the same show. This format will also help ensure that more classes fill.

Riders and trainers are responsible for following the eligibility membership requirements of each association.

**SCHSA Challenge and LAHJA Gold**

**Fences 3'3"**

This class may be held in either the jumper arena or the hunter arena, and is designed as an advanced equitation class. Riders will compete over fences. A work off of at least three riders is required as long as the riders have a score of 70 or better. If no riders score at least 70 in the jumping round, there will be no work off and riders will be placed based on their jumping round score. The work off may be flat work only or the judge may include jumping tests.

**SCHSA Junior/Amateur and LAHJA Junior and Senior Silver**

**Fences 3'0"**

This class will be conducted using a hunt seat equitation course and consists of a jumping round, followed by a flat phase of at least eight riders, if available regardless of score. Riders must have completed the jumping phase in order to compete in the flat phase. This class may be split junior and amateur if there are at least four riders in each category.

Jumping Phase: 60% Flat Phase: 40%

**SCHSA 2'6" Junor/Amateur and LAHJA Bronze Child/Adult**

**Fences 2'6"**

This class will be conducted using a hunt seat equitation course and consists of a jumping round, followed by a flat phase of at least eight riders, if available regardless of score. Riders must have completed the jumping phase in order to compete in the flat phase.

Jumping Phase: 60% Flat Phase: 40%

**SCHSA Futures and LAHJA Copper**

**Fences 2'0"**

This class will be conducted using a hunt seat equitation course with two tests built into the course. This is an introductory medal class and the tests should be appropriate for the level of rider.

**The LAHJA Copper 2'3" and LAHJA Bronze 2'9" will be offered as standalone classes when the LAHJA Copper 2'0" and LAHJA Bronze 2'6" are held as joint classes with SCHSA.**
